Welcome to the 2021-2022 school year. Registration dates and times are listed below. Please use our online registration system located on our website to enroll your student at www.eaglepnt.k12.or.us – click on the registration link. Completing the necessary forms prior to Orientation day will help expedite the registration process. A parent or guardian is encouraged to accompany their student through the Orientation process. **If a parent is unable to attend with their student, please be sure to complete all necessary electronic forms in advance. ALL students need to complete registration.**

PLEASE NOTE - DUE TO ONGOING CONSTRUCTION AT THE FRONT AND SOUTH SIDE OF THE BUILDING YOU WILL NEED TO ACCESS THE BUILDING FROM THE BACK BY THE PRACTICE/SOCCER FIELDS. WE WILL HAVE SIGNAGE UP.

Per state guidelines, MASKS will be required in all school buildings.

Information

SCHOOL BASED HEALTH CENTER: EPHS has a state certified school based health center on campus. If your student is under 15 years, the consent form is required to access services. If your student is 15 or older, access to services is available without consent per Oregon law. If you do not want your student to access the Health Center, you must fill out and sign the OPT out form. For more information contact the Program Manager at 541-830-6617.

REGISTRATION FEE WORK SHEET: A fee worksheet has been made available online to help you figure costs for the school year. Please bring a check/cash/money order with you to orientation to cover fees, or you may also pay online.

Individual teachers will assess any class fees for materials, etc., after classes begin. *Change cannot be given back from checks. Any overpayment will be deposited into your student's security deposit account.*

STUDENT IDENTIFICATION CARDS: Student identification cards with photos ARE REQUIRED at EPHS. Student ID's must be carried by all students, at all times. Students without ID or who vandalize their ID will be required to purchase a new one before attending class. The fee for a replacement card is \$8 (subsequent fees may be higher). Student ID cards must be shown to use the library, access breakfast/lunch meals, and to attend games and dances. Student ID Cards will be needed to access off-campus lunch privilege. ID photos will be taken during registration. Students will receive their student identification cards upon completion of registration. ID cards are a \$10 annual fee. All ID cards come with an Activity Sticker which grants students free admission to home games (with the exception of OSAA playoff games, endowment games) and reduced admission to school dances (with the exception of Homecoming, MORP and PROM and a few specialty dances).

TECHNOLOGY: All students will receive an individual iPad for the school year. You can find more information regarding the iPads on the district website: www.eaglepnt.k12.or.us, click on Teaching & Learning, then Digital Learning. You will find several links here to help you with iPads. There is an iPad Insurance Protection Coverage of \$25.00. Without insurance, students will be responsible for ALL repair or replacement costs. Full replacement costs are \$299. For full details of the insurance coverage see "Student Costs" in the EPSD9 Technology Handbook available on the website.

EPHS PARKING PERMIT APPLICATION- If a student plans to drive a vehicle to school this year, he/she is required to purchase a parking permit and register the vehicle(s). You can register for a parking permit here: [Parking Policy](#). You will receive your parking permit from Student Services after school starts. The cost is \$10.00 and must be paid prior to receiving your parking permit.

EPHS HALL LOCKER POLICY: If a school locker is desired, a locker form needs to be completed. **A parent and student signature is required on this form.** School issued locks are required for school lockers. The price of a lock is \$6. School issued locks stay on the student locker and only need to be purchased one time. *For incoming freshman, there is a \$6 lock fee and \$6 locker use fee for a total of \$12.* Incoming freshman – please complete a locker form and turn in at registration if you desire to have a hall locker. Any other students', who do not currently have a locker, and would like one, please see Student Services in the front office.

FREE AND REDUCED MEAL BENEFITS: If you wish to apply for free and reduced meal benefits you can apply online at <https://district.ode.state.or.us/apps/frlapp/default.aspx> or complete the paper application form. **Applications for free and reduced meals must be submitted for approval each school year.** For more information concerning this program/process, contact the Food Services Supervisor @ 541-830-6553.

SCHOOL PICTURES: School pictures will be taken at registration by Lifetouch. All students are required to have their picture taken for their student identification cards. You will receive information from Lifetouch prior to registration. If you want to purchase pictures, Lifetouch requires a separate payment. Please make a separate check payable to *Lifetouch*.

P.E./SPORTS LOCKERS: Students enrolled in a P.E. class or participating in sports are required to have a school lock on their P.E./sports locker (any personal locks will be removed). A locker form and locker fee is not required for a sports locker. A padlock will be assigned/provided with the sports locker. The padlocks are the property of the school. If the

padlock is lost there will be a fee of \$6 for a replacement lock. The receipt must be shown to the coach or P.E. teacher to receive a new lock. All students enrolled in any P.E. class will be required to purchase and wear an EPHS P.E. uniform. The cost is payable at registration.

SPORTS/ACTIVITY INFORMATION: Oregon School Activities Association requires that all students participating in sports and activities be covered by insurance before being allowed to participate. A copy of your insurance card needs to be submitted to the Athletic Department yearly. In addition, students who do not have insurance can purchase insurance for the year or seasonally. Contact the Athletic Director for more information. Proof of insurance coverage, physical forms and eligibility information **MUST** be turned in **PRIOR** to the first day of practice before any student may participate. Eligibility, insurance, fee information and physical forms are available in the athletic/activity office.
