

What is the Employee Assistance Program?



FAQs: DJUSD Employee Assistance Program

Q: What is an EAP?

A: EAP is short for Employee Assistance Program - a benefit provided by Psychological Resource Associates (PRA) and paid by your employer without any cost to you.

It provides you initial access to counseling and therapy to address concerns and issues in your life.

It also provides you a place to confidentially discuss your concerns in an effort to prevent or alleviate your sense of being overwhelmed or "alone".

Q: Who has to know that I am using the EAP program?

A: EAP sessions, like any medical appointment, are completely confidential. Only you, your therapist, and the Intake Coordinator at PRA need to know.

Q: My job site can't afford to have someone be away from their job if they're not sick. How can I attend appointments?

A: DJUSD values each employee and provides the EAP so that the stress of personal issues you are facing does not adversely affect your job performance.

If you have no sick or vacation leave, DJUSD allows employees to use Comp Time for appointments.

Q: My supervisor will know if I ask for time off to use EAP.

A: EAP services are like medical appointments; you can request time off for medical reasons without stating that it is for your EAP.

Q: I'd still rather not miss any work for an appointment.

A: PRA has some limited space for evening, lunch time, and Saturday appointments.
