

Informed Consent and Release of Information for COVID-19 Diagnostic Testing

Consent to COVID-19 Diagnostic Testing

I voluntarily consent and authorize UC San Diego Health, Clarity Lab Solutions, LLC, and/or Responsive Partners, LLC, in conjunction with San Diego Unified School District, to conduct collection, testing, and analysis for the purposes of COVID-19 diagnostic tests on the student (named below).

I acknowledge and understand that the COVID-19 diagnostic test will require the collection of an appropriate sample through an anterior nasal swab, oral swab, or other recommended collection procedures.

I assume complete and full responsibility to take appropriate action with regards to test results. Should I have questions or concerns regarding student test results or physical condition, I shall promptly seek advice and treatment from an appropriate medical provider.

I understand that there will be no charge or payment to student, parent or to health insurance for this diagnostic test.

I understand that signing this form authorizes UC San Diego Health, Clarity Lab Solutions, LLC, and/or Responsive Partners, LLC, to test the student named below on multiple occasions (such as weekly, twice weekly, every 2 weeks, every 3 weeks or less frequently), depending on availability of test and virus circumstances in our community. I consent to my student being tested without my presence through June 30, 2022.

I understand that I can cancel this Consent in writing at any time prior to the test being administered and my student will no longer be tested. If I notify San Diego Unified School District in writing to cancel this Consent, UC San Diego Health, Clarity Lab Solutions, LLC, and/or Responsive Partners, LLC will no longer test my child.

For students receiving a COVID-19 test from UCSD:

- I understand that there is a requirement for my child to be registered as a UC San Diego Health patient (if not already registered) and to be registered with MyUCSDChart for tracking purposes.
- Parents will be telephoned by UC San Diego Health for any positive result for explanation and instructions. Negative results will be available on MyUCSDChart only.

Release of Information for Clarity Lab Solutions LLC, Responsive Partners LLC, and Primary Diagnostics, Inc.

I understand that my student may receive a COVID-19 diagnostic test from Clarity Lab Solutions LLC, Responsive Partners, LLC, and/or UC San Diego Health, as available. I further understand that my student may receive a state provided COVID-19 diagnostic test. Primary Diagnostics, Inc. is the state platform used to collect COVID-19 test results and related information from state provided diagnostic tests.

I authorize Clarity Lab Solutions, LLC, Responsive Partners, LLC, and/or Primary Diagnostics, Inc. to release personal information for student (including name, gender, date of birth, and, to the extent applicable, dependent and/or guardianship information), contact information (including, to the extent applicable, my telephone number, email address, and physical or mailing address), appointment information, transaction identification number, COVID-19 test information and results, to San Diego Unified School District, county and state health department, or to any other governmental entity as may be required by law.

District will notify me by telephone for any positive test result. Negative test results may be obtained by calling my student's school site nurse.

Release of Information for UC San Diego Health

I understand that if my student receives a COVID-19 test from UC San Diego Health, I will be asked to also complete UC San Diego Health's Release of Information Form.

I understand that the UC San Diego Health forms ask me for a Social Security Number, but that I am not required to provide this and testing will be provided whether a Social Security Number is provided or not. **Whether or not a Social Security Number is provided will not impact a student's eligibility for enrollment or receipt of educational services. Social security numbers, or the fact that one was not provided will not be shared by the District except with UC San Diego Health and UC San Diego Health will not share this information with any other person or entity.**

UC San Diego Health Teaching, Training and Education

I understand that as part of its teaching mission, UCSDH teaches and trains students in health care careers and that a supervised trainee may administer the COVID-19 test to my child.
