**For information about TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families), JOBS Program, Child Support, or Food Assistance call the main number. (TANF is designed to provide benefits and services to needy families with children so that children may be cared for in their own homes or in the homes of relatives. These services also promote job preparation, work and marriage and the prevention of out of wedlock pregnancy. Families can get temporary cash assistance for basic needs for low income families with children under the age of 18 or 19 if he/she is a full-time student in a secondary school or in the equivalent level of vocational or technical training. The JOBS Program provides work and training services to all parents receiving cash assistance to help find and retain employment.

**CMA (Child Care Management Agencies)—provide Alabama's low income and moderate-income families with equal access to affordable and quality child care services as they participate in work, educational or training activities.
